9. What happens when we reveal our sin to someone else?
10. Read Psalm 29. What are the reasons mentioned here you feel God is to be honored?
11. After reading Psalm 29, what are your thoughts about the voice of the Lord?
12. How does God speak to us?
13. What does *confident* mean?
14. How can we ask God for something in a humble but in a confident manner?
15. What guidelines must we follow when asking God for something?
16. What does it mean to ask according to God's will?
17. Why do we need to ask according to His will?
18. What can be God's answers to our prayers? Just because we don't get the answer we want, does that mean God didn't hear our prayers?
19. Why do we have to make a conscious decision to thank God?
