

# Bible Reading Plan 2024



## August 2024 – The Book of Deuteronomy

Written by Moses and the fifth and final book of the Pentateuch, Deuteronomy gives us a review of the desert wanderings, the commandments and laws of God, and a renewal of the covenant with the children of Israel and their God. The first and greatest commandment is emphasized to the people and their future generations: “You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise” (6:7). They must not only learn from their mistakes, but they must pass on the faith. Following the laws of God will reap blessings and breaking the laws of God will bring judgment (Ch. 28). The final chapters give a look at the future with the coming death of Moses and Joshua’s leadership now in effect. We can learn much from this book by reminding ourselves often of the faithfulness of God by writing it down, not only for ourselves but for future generations.
