December 2025 – The Coming Messiah

The first chapter of the book of John gives us insight into who Jesus really is, the Word of God who became flesh and dwelt among us. In this book, He is also called the Christ (Anointed One or Messiah) and the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Throughout the Old Testament, we are given insight into His coming.
