Bible Reading Plan 2025



November 2025 - Ezekiel

The book of Ezekiel was written during the Babylonian captivity of the Jews. Ezekiel ministered to his generation who were both exceedingly sinful and thoroughly hopeless. By means of his prophetic ministry he attempted to bring them to immediate repentance and to confidence in the distant future. He discovered God was not confined to the narrow strictures of Ezekiel's native land. Instead, He is a universal God who commands and controls persons and nations. Ezekiel's ministry began with condemnation and judgment of the nation of Judah. After the destruction of Jerusalem, Ezekiel's prophecies spoke of hope for the future. Ezekiel wanted to help the people learn from their failures. He announced impending judgment upon the nations that surrounded Judah and reestablished hope for the restoration of Israel. His vision of the valley of dry bones (Ch. 37) pictured new life being breathed into the nation. That prophecy will be ultimately fulfilled in the millennial reign of Christ on earth (*Got Questions*).
